

How to Make Dinosaur Clothespin / Peg Puppets

I bet Tim would have loved to play these with his foster siblings!

What you need:

- Dino puppet shapes, with large heads like the pictures below!
- heavier print paper
- clothespin / Pegs (wooden is best) – the kind that snap open and close
- glue
- scissors

Step by Step Instructions

Draw, colour and cut out your dino head templates.

You need to make sure the head is **larger** than the body so you can cut it in half.

Yes, cut the head horizontally in half (through the mouth) once you've coloured and decorated as you like.

I recommend printing on heavier print paper for more durability.

Tip: Once you cut out the puppets, you can also laminate the puppet parts to make it last even longer!

Glue or stick to the pegs and roar away!
